The Industry Grouping has been set up

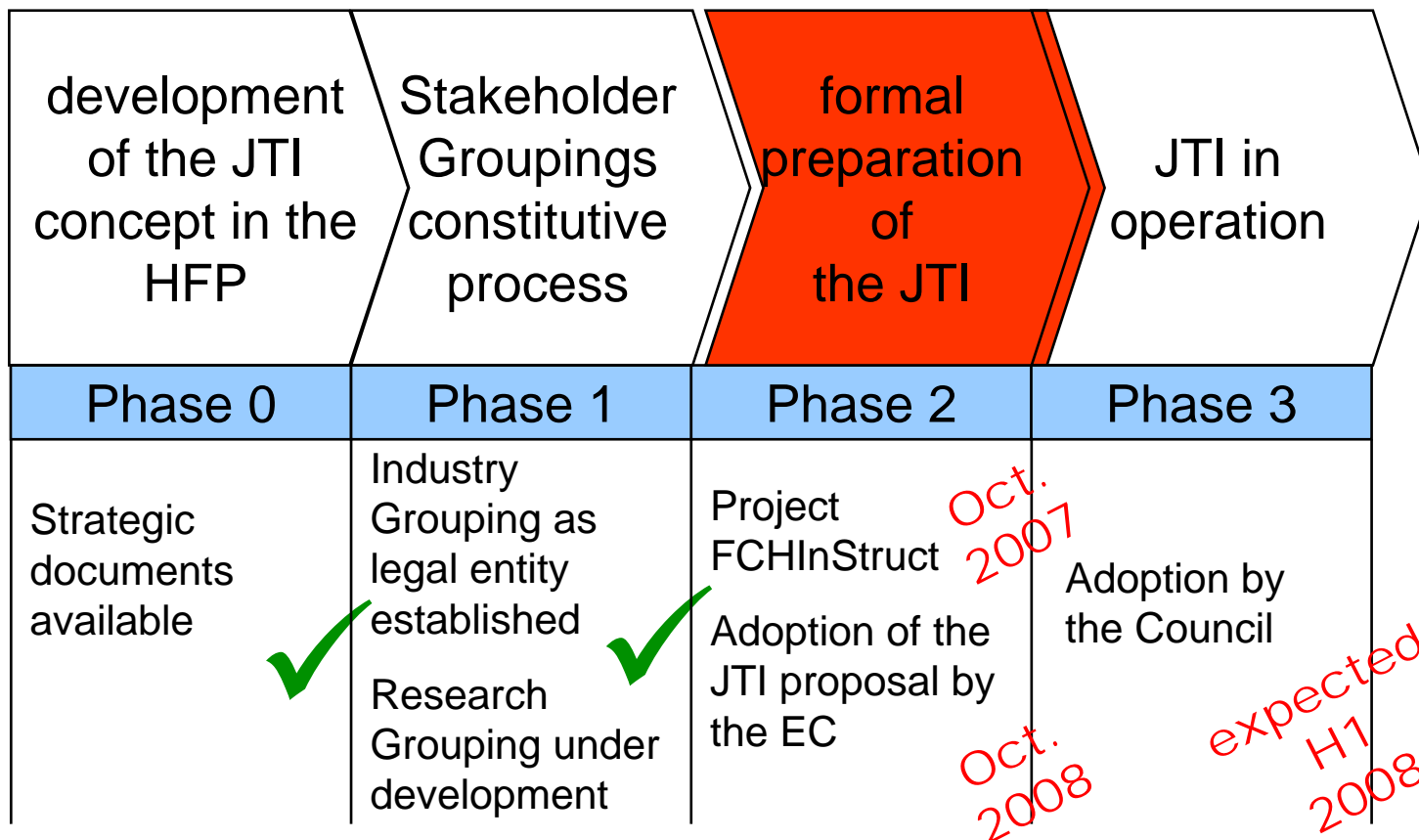
- 50 companies from 13 countries, target 65 by end 2007

- Shares 50% of the JTI Program Office cost



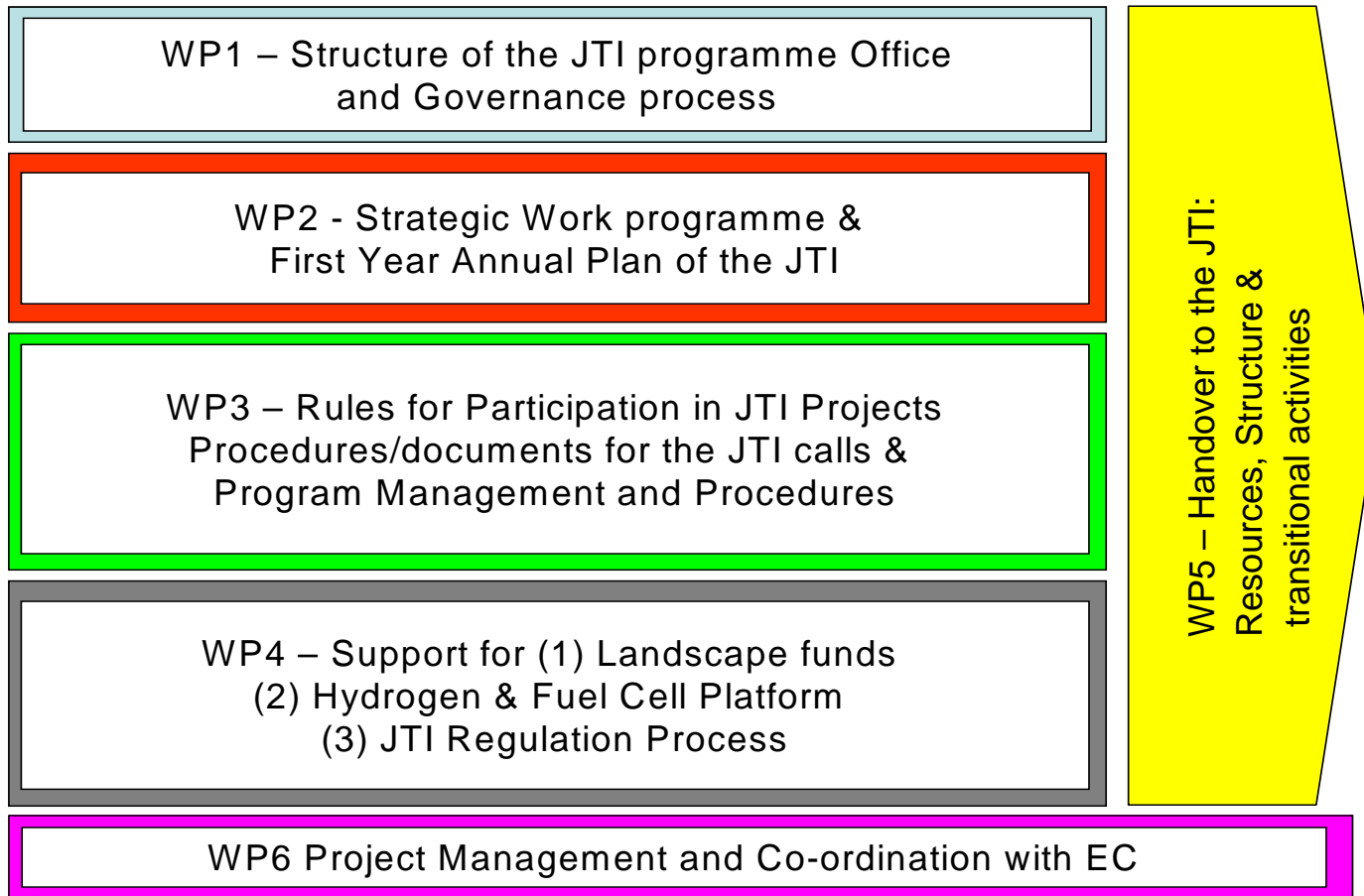

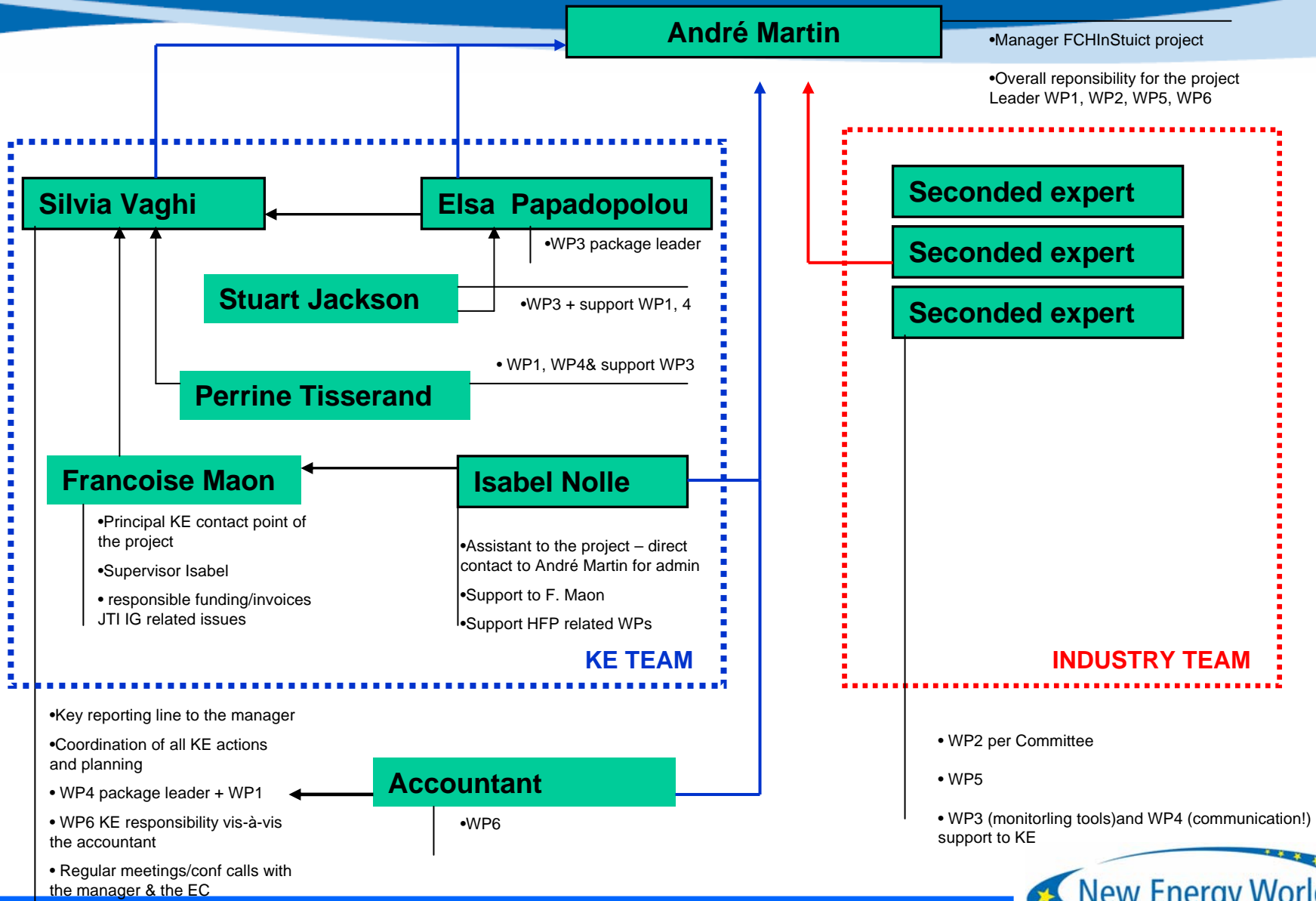

FCHInStruct Scope of Work



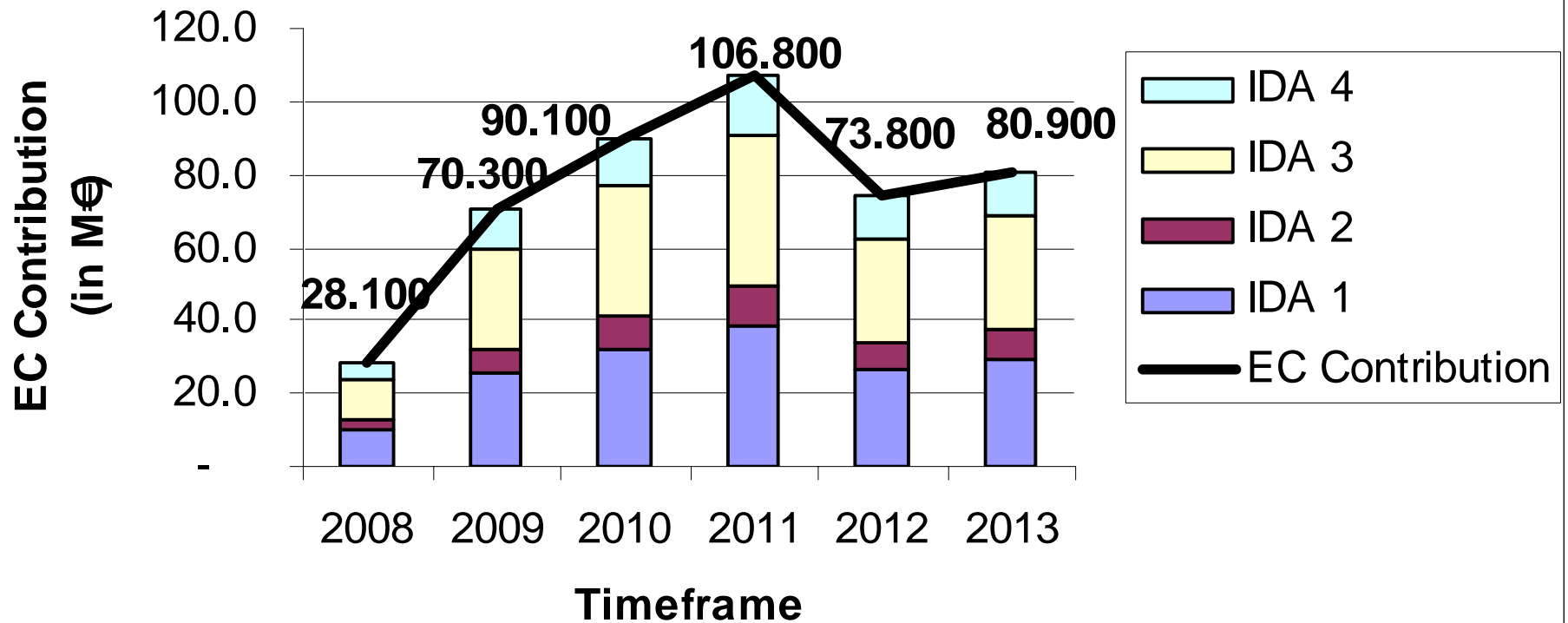

Focus on Strategic Program Activities
