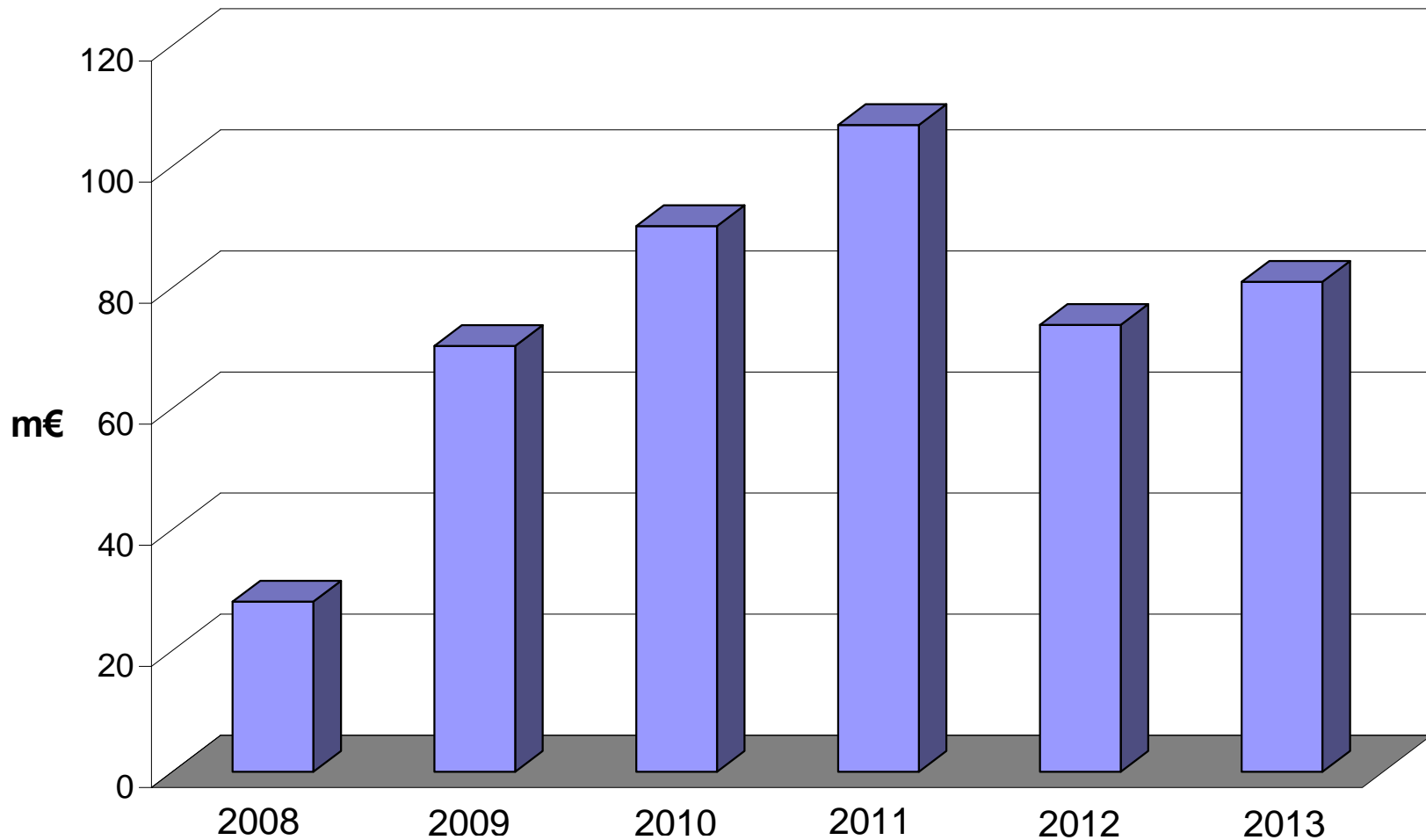

# *Recent developments*

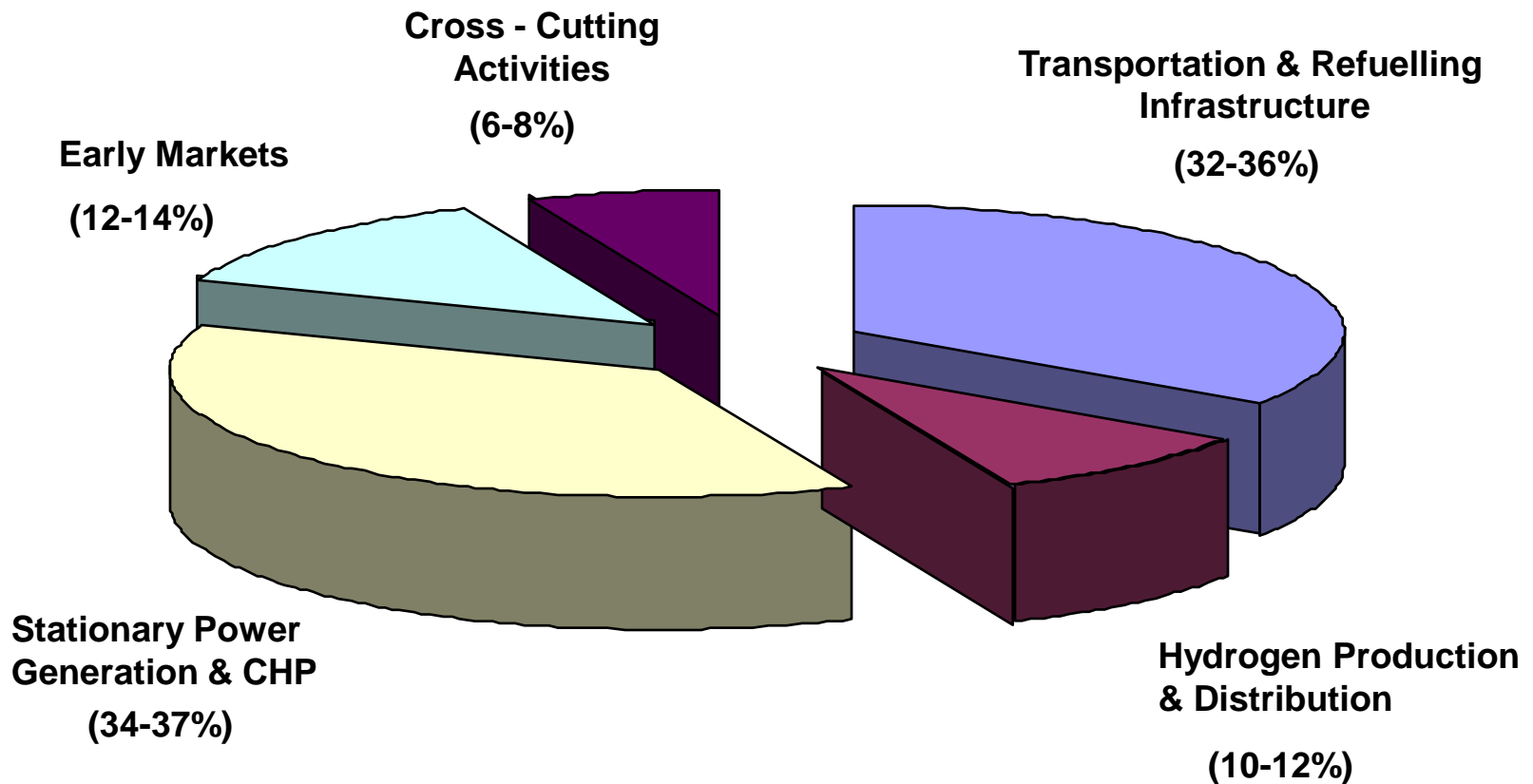


- MAIP adopted at the GB meeting on 15/05/2009

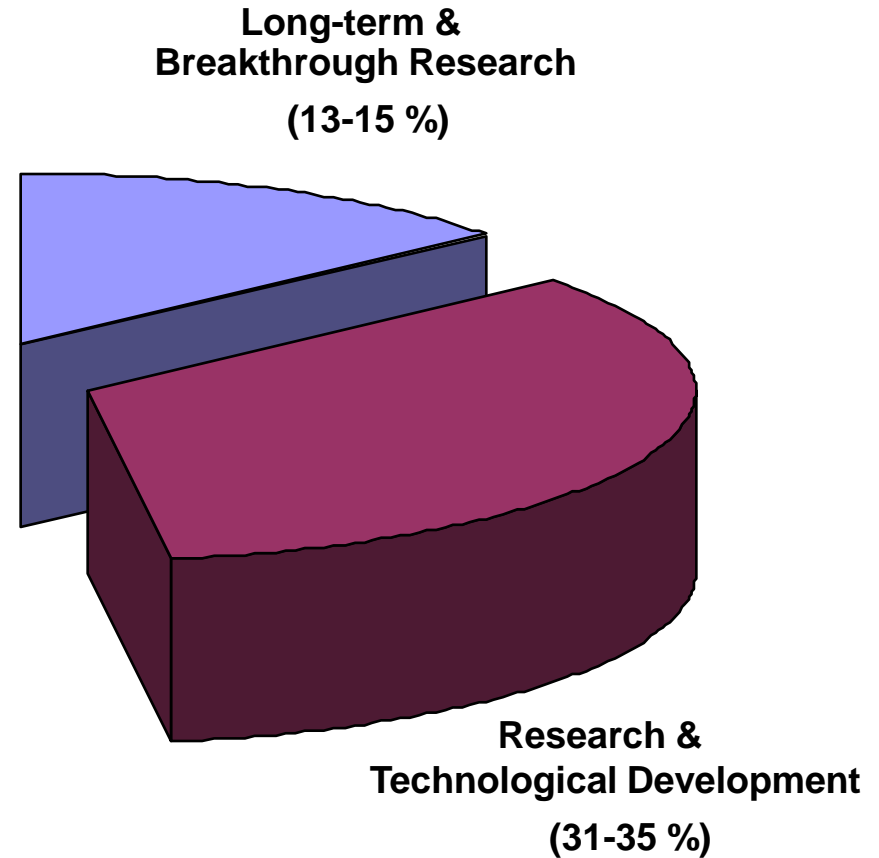
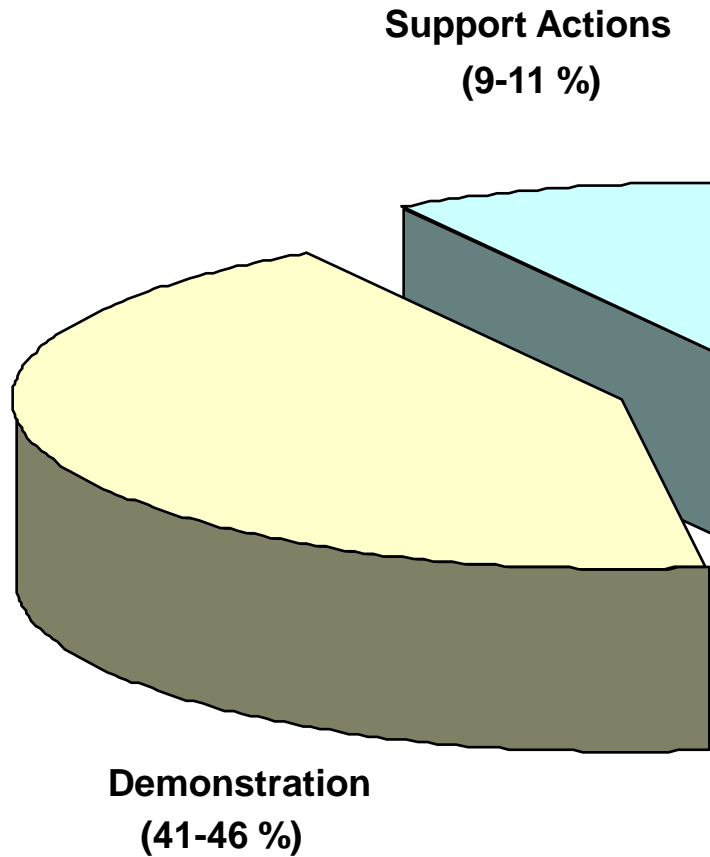
# Budget of annual calls

  - Modalities for the interface with other EU policies
