National programs for hydrogen research and demonstration

- **The Research Council of Norway has had two big research programs which have supported hydrogen research.**
 - **RENERGI:** (Clean energy for the future) supports general research on hydrogen systems and technology development.
 - **NANOMAT:** (Nanotechnology and new materials) focuses on research on materials for hydrogen storage.
 - Total amount of money spent on hydrogen R&D in 2010 was 4.5 M€.
- **The Norwegian government established a new organization called Transnova in 2009.**
 - Purpose is to support projects which can lead to lower emissions from the transport sector.
 - Organization in a test period from Q1 2009 until Q4 2011. In Q3 2011 government will decide if to be continued.
 - Yearly budget of 6 M€
 - ~50% of budget used on hydrogen technologies.

Ongoing demonstration projects

Total national support for demonstration projects in 2010: 3.8 M€

- **The HyNor project** (<http://www.hynor.no>): Joint public-private partnership initiated to demonstrate real life implementation of hydrogen energy infrastructure along a 580 kilometre road stretch from Oslo to Stavanger. Currently 4 hydrogen refuelling stations are installed:
 - Stavanger (2006), Porsgrunn (2007), 2 in Oslo (2009)
- **Upcoming hydrogen stations in 2011 and 2012:**
 - 3 car stations: Stavanger, Lillestrøm(just north of Oslo) and Oslo(H2-Moves)
 - Bus-station in Oslo
- **H2-Moves Scandinavia**
 - Oslo chosen as main-site lighthouse project on hydrogen infrastructure.
 - A fleet of 17 fuel cell vehicles will arrive with the new stations, making the total amount of hydrogen vehicles in Norway close to 40.
- **HyNor Oslo Bus (CHIC Oslo)**
 - Bus-project in Oslo part of the EU-project **Clean Hydrogen In European Cities**
 - Bus-manufacturer chosen (oct 2010): VanHool (will deliver 5 buses in Q1 2012)

Other hydrogen projects (cont.)

- **NextMove – Interreg project**

3 year project between Norway, Sweden and Denmark on preparing the potential users of hydrogen vehicles, coordinating work on communication, car acquisition, leasing etc..

- **Possibility study, Oslo Gardermoen airport**

- Funding received to look at possibilities for utilizing hydrogen at the national airport at Gardermoen.
